Four independently controlled burners

Requires separate propane tank

Two removable front drip cups







Who It Is For

-  People who cook outdoors for groups of six to ten
-  Tailgaters and campers wanting a portable flat-top
-  Cooks who need separate hot and cool zones
-  Hosts who prefer a continuous griddle surface



Who It Is Not For

-  Small households that cook for one or two
-  Indoor-only kitchens where gas appliances are prohibited
-  Homes without room for a 64.6 inch wide unit
-  Buyers needing a built-in permanent grill installation

Trade Offs to Consider

- Heavy 96 pound unit limits solo moving
- Large footprint even when folded for storage
- Propane tank not included adds extra purchase
- Cold-rolled steel surface requires routine upkeep

How It Compares

- Larger flat-top area than typical two-burner griddles
- Higher total BTU than many portable griddle models
- Folds for transport unlike some fixed-frame flat tops

Choose This If...

- ✓ You regularly cook outdoors for medium to large groups
- ✓ You need independent heat zones for different foods
- ✓ You want a portable griddle with high cooking capacity

Skip This If...

- ✗ You only need a compact griddle for one or two
- ✗ You require an indoor electric or built-in grill
- ✗ You cannot lift or move a roughly 96 pound unit
