Who It Is Not For

- ✗ Large families or parties
- ✗ Users needing high-heat searing
- ✗ Those wanting permanent backyard setups
- ✗ People who want multi-burner grills



Trade Offs to Consider

- Smaller 150 sq in surface
- Single burner limits heat control
- Requires small propane canisters
- No extra burners or accessories

- ✓ Dishwasher-safe grate simplifies cleaning

● COMPLAINTS

- ⚠ Small cooking area for larger groups
- ⚠ Limited heat compared to larger grills
- ⚠ Not suitable for heavy searing



How It Compares

- Smaller than full-size gas grills
- More portable than tank-style grills
- Less heat than multi-burner models
- Quicker cleanup than cast-iron grates
