At a Glance Specs

 FUEL TYPE Charcoal fuel only	 COOKING AREA About 205 square inches
 GRATE THICKNESS 3.5 mm cooking bars	 WEIGHT About 8 pounds
 FOLDED THICKNESS Folds to about 1 inch	 OPEN HEIGHT Stands about 13 inches tall
 MATERIAL High-heat painted alloy steel	 ASSEMBLY No assembly required

Who It Is For

-  Car campers and tailgaters needing portability
-  Picnickers and beachgoers with limited gear
-  People with tight storage space at home
-  Users who want a quick reusable grill

Who It Is Not For

-  Cooking for large groups or events
-  Indoor or smoke-restricted environments
-  Those needing precise temperature control
-  Users who prefer gas or electric grills

Trade Offs to Consider

-  Very small cooking capacity versus portability
-  Charcoal fuel requires starter and cleanup
-  Single foldable grate limits simultaneous items
-  3.5mm bars are thinner than heavy-duty grates

- ✓ Portable fold-flat design praised for storage
- ✓ Lightweight for easy transport
- ✓ Simple setup with no assembly

● COMPLAINTS

- ⚠ Small cooking area limits batch cooking
- ⚠ Charcoal-only operation needs more effort
- ⚠ Grate thickness can feel lightweight for heavy pans



How It Compares

- Smaller than full-size charcoal grills but far more portable
- Compared with portable gas grills: charcoal only no instant ignition
- Better than disposables: reusable higher capacity and sturdier build



Choose This If...

- ✓ You need an ultra-compact reusable charcoal grill
- ✓ Portability and low storage footprint matter most
- ✓ You usually cook for one to two people



Skip This If...

- ✗ You regularly cook for large groups
- ✗ You need indoor or low-smoke grilling
- ✗ You require gas or instant-start convenience
