Who It Is For

- ✓ Hosts who cook for large groups regularly
- ✓ Backyard cooks wanting charcoal flavor at scale
- ✓ Event or catering cooks needing continuous grilling
- ✓ Users who value a built-in lid thermometer



Who It Is Not For

- ✗ Apartment or balcony users with limited space
- ✗ Buyers who need quick gas ignition
- ✗ Frequent campers seeking a lightweight portable grill
- ✗ Shoppers who avoid assembly or heavy lifts



Trade Offs to Consider

- Very heavy at 134.5 pounds
- Large footprint limits small outdoor spaces
- Charcoal fuel requires more startup and cleanup
- Single-level grate reduces multi-tier cooking options

● POSITIVES

- ✓ Ample cooking space for big batches
- ✓ Hinged grate simplifies adding charcoal mid-cook
- ✓ Porcelain enamel holds heat and resists rust

● COMPLAINTS

- ⚠ Heavy and difficult to reposition
- ⚠ Requires assembly before first use



How It Compares

- Much larger cooking area than standard kettles
- More capacity than portable charcoal grills
- Less instant-start convenience than gas grills

- ✓ You want a hinged grate and lid thermometer

- × You need a compact portable grill
- × You prefer gas or electric ignition
